- 01) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
- 02) *Understanding* the current global economic crisis is causing
- 03) economic problems worldwide,
- 04) *Remembering* that the American's Great Depression was
- 05) worsened by closing off their borders,
- 06) *Concerned* for the nations who are not currently involved in
- 07) trade,
- 08) 1. Authorizes the United Nations Conference on Trade and
- 09) Development to create regional and global trading groups
- 10) with special emphasis on trade in developing nations;
- 11) 2. Further encourages the Conference on Trade and
- 12) Development to be held annually as opposed to once every
- 13) four years;
- 14) 3. Deplores countries to keep open borders and continue in
- 15) trade in order to maintain the global economy;
- 16) 4. Requests that all nations move towards free trade policies in
- 17) order to have a stronger economic policy.
- 18) 5. Encourages countries with embargoes and tariffs to give up
- 19) these restrictions gradually in exchange for assisted access to
- 20) free trade with countries with stable economies.
- 18) 6. Further encourages the Conference on Trade and
- 19) Development to be held annually as opposed to once every
- 20) four years;
- 21) 7. Recommends assisting countries in advancing as many free
- 22) trade agreements (FTA) as possible.
