Subject: Children's Rights

Proposed By: The Republic of Poland

- 01) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
- 02) *Fully aware* that children's rights are violated in many countries
- 03) worldwide.
- 04) *Emphasizing* that proper education for children is the strongest
- 05) promoter of their rights and dignity.
- 06) *Acknowledging* the United Nations's responsibility to improve
- 07) the rights of children,
- 08) 1. Calls upon greater efforts by UNICEF to raise awareness
- 09) about child labor by:
- 10) a) Financial aid for the countries that improve the number
- 11) of girls in school
- 12) b) The United Nations supports existing single sex school
- 13) and will support and designate UNICEF funds toward the
- 14) creation of single sex schools where young women would
- 15) otherwise not receive an adequate education. In these
- 16) communities, gender equality would be emphasized in
- 17) the curriculum, through:
- 18) 1. Required stricter border patrol to eliminate the
- 19) trafficking of children
- 20) 2. Heightened government security regarding the
- 21) participation of those under eighteen years of age in
- 22) any kind of military action
- 23) 3. Inviting the United Nations summit by inviting child
- 24) ambassadors to United Nations to advocate their
- 25) right to education
- 26) 4. Implemented outreach and rehabilitation programs
- 27) to introduce victims back into society and prevent
- 28) the same crimes from occurring again;
- 29) 2. Proclaims that there will be suitable punishment for
- 30) countries that do not ratify the document or fail to comply

- 31) with the regulations they have agreed to:
- 32) a) In cases of issue such as neglect to comply with a
- 33) specific area of the United Nations document, the
- 34) country at fault will be
- 35) 1. Alerted to the problem or area of neglect
- 36) 2. Expected to immediately attend to the error
- 37) 3. Temporarily suspended from participation in United
- 38) Nations human rights related functions;
- 39) 3. Calls for the rehabilitation and outreach program included in
- 40) the proposed United Nations document on children to
- 41) be thorough and expansive, regarding:
- 42) a) Enrollment or reintroduction into schools that offer an
- 43) education that is designed to integrate the needs,
- 44) responsibilities and tradition of the local culture to
- 45) provide children of opportunity for success; such an
- 46) education would include instruction regarding the
- 47) prevention of diseases as HIV/AIDS
- 48) b) Preparing victims to live and work successfully as adults
- 49) through job training or college options
- 50) c) Providing aid to at-risk children to prevent the
- 51) desperation that leads to children in militias, through
- 52) 1. Medical attention to those without resources
- 53) 2. Food and water available though food banks and
- 54) public centers
- 55) 3. Shelters for those children without proper homes and
- 56) for abused and/or sexually exploited children.
