- 01) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,
- 02) *Observing* the fact that Iraq is ranked last in child mortality
- 03) throughout the world,
- 04) *Noting with deep concern* the high rate of female mortality in Iraq,
- 05) *Aware* of the fact that the high death rate of children and women is
- 06) caused by the lack of law and order,
- 07) *Realizing* that the lack of clean water, electricity, and too few
- 08) hospitals contribute to the lack of child security and exponentially high
- 09) death rate,
- 10) *Noting further* that while the interim constitution in Iraq did an
- 11) excellent job in more rights to women and children,
- 12) *Recognizing* the fact that the current constitution has yet to give more
- 13) women's and children's rights back to its citizens,
- 14) 1. Reminds the United Nations of its recent announcement to
- 15) continue its support for developing legislation in Iraq for the
- 16) protection of women and children's rights;
- 17) 2. Further reminds the United Nations of its formation of the United
- 18) Nations Assistance Mission for Iraq Subdivision as well as holding
- 19) several conferences for even more in depth help within the
- 20) country;
- 21) 3. Expresses its hope of encouraging other war torn, unstable
- 22) nations to join Iraq in its attempt to draw a greater attention to
- 23) the growing issue concerning children's and women's security;
- 24) 4. Requests the United Nations to continue with the help and
- 25) seminars they are holding to place pressure on the Iraqi
- 26) government to give a greater attention to increasing women's and
- 27) children's rights and security.
