1 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

2 *Deeply Concerned* for the safety of participants of political rallies,

3 *Alarmed* by the high number of attacks that hit people all over the world  
4 who participate in political events and actions,

5 *Recognizing* that attacks on political rallies causes fear in the voting  
6 population causes them to question whether or not their right to vote is  
7 threatened. In addition, these attacks have the potential to effect political  
8 outcomes,

9 *Recognizing* The United Nations urgency toward the issue of political violence  
10 and their efforts to speak out about the danger of voting especially  
11 Afghanistan including the United Nations mission in Afghanistan (UNAMA)  
12 calling for the elections to be held in a safe and secure environment,

13 *Having examined* Security Council's statement that "violence in any form, or  
14 the threat thereof, intended to disrupt the elections and democratic process  
15 is unacceptable" and The United Nations' utilization of Electric Observation  
16 and Supervisions of Election to intervene on elections and check credibility,

- 17 1. Draws attention to the rising number of attacks on political rallies;
- 18 2. Supports the United Nation's role in Afghanistan calling for elections to  
19 be held in a safe and secure environment;
- 20 3. Supports the United Nations' utilization of the Electoral Observation  
21 and Supervision of Election;
- 22 4. Requests nations to hold elections in safe and secure environments;
- 23 5. Requests funding to go to securing and monitoring political sites to  
24 limit attacks and ensure the safety of participants of political activity;
