1 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

2 *Concerned* about how the large amount of violence during elections  
3 will affect people trying to vote peacefully,

4 *Aware* of the cause of terrorism and political attacks, due to the fact  
5 that it's caused by lack of resources and corrupt governments,

6 *Recognizing* efforts taken by the United Nations to decrease the  
7 amount of violence by creating safer environments for voters and  
8 candidates, and improving overall security in developing countries that  
9 need it the most,

10 1. Urges developing countries to recall various methods of security  
11 and protection in order to keep citizens safe and secure from  
12 political attacks;

13 2. Condemns the idea of removing freedoms associated with  
14 political expression and tactics used to harm humanity;

15 3. Requests the United Nations to help repair corrupt governments  
16 and increase security in developing countries that need it most,  
17 as well as providing a safe and peaceful voting environment for  
18 each person involved;

19 4. Urges more developed countries to improve their ability to  
20 provide a decent environment for candidates and journalists  
21 during election processes, as well as helping developing nations  
22 increase protection, in efforts to help the government towards a  
23 democracy;

24 5. Calls upon the United Nations to send people down to developing  
25 countries and educate citizens on the dangers behind political  
26 attacks and make sure a plan is established for when an attack  
27 does occur;

28 6. Encourages developed countries to provide assistance and  
29 security for developing countries, so voting environments  
30 become safer and candidates are provided a good environment  
31 to speak in;

32 7. Recommends that security guards and drones are essential to  
33 providing security and locating terrorists in the event of an  
34 attack;

35 8. Commends the United Nations and European Union for their  
36 efforts in trying to establish peace and making the election  
37 process smoother for those who want to use their voices for  
38 good.
