1 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY,

2 *Emphasizing* the focus on all forms of human trafficking such as blackmail,
3 kidnapping, sex trade, sexual exploitation, false promises, and luring, in
4 order to trap women and young teens,

5 *Bearing in mind* the poverty and vulnerability these women and children face
6 as they trust men in order to guaranty a better life for themselves due to the
7 detriment of their current situation,

8 *Affirming* how boarder security is weak in most nations which allow for these
9 people to be taking into differing nations, making them go off the radar of
10 their current home, causing them to be suddenly stuck inside the trade,

11 *Having considered* how the United Nations has continued their Global Plan of
12 Action to stop sex trafficking along with their 2030 Agenda for Sustainable
13 Development through the education of young children and looking at the
14 root of the problem; poverty, inequality, and vulnerability,

- 15 1. Encourages tighter boarder security in order to monitor those who are
16 freely entering and leaving countries, causing for sooner identification
17 of women who are being trafficked before they go into a differing
18 nation;
- 19 2. Recommends more education for police and law enforcements to
20 create different systems which can be utilized to identify those who are
21 being trafficked;
- 22 3. Further requests there to be more communication and education in
23 schools for children to further learn about ending cycles of abuse;
- 24 4. Encourages adults to take the same course of action in order to
25 broaden their skills and become stronger role models for their children
26 to help better a brighter future for the children of the future
